

LaSalle High School Offers SAT and ACT Prep Courses:

Test preparation is no different than any other skill: The more the student learns and practices, the better the student becomes. Based on this premise, LaSalle is offering focused, standardized test preparation courses. Our approach involves testing, skills review, problem solving, concepts and strategies, and practice materials. The course is open to LaSalle, McAuley, and Mercy senior and junior students who intend to take the May 1st SAT or the April 10th ACT.

Students should choose either the SAT or the ACT prep option.

Sessions:

SAT classes are Tuesdays, from 5:30-8:30 P.M. Sessions are February 16 and 23; March 2, 9, 16, and 30; April 13 and 20.

ACT classes are Tuesdays, from 5:30-8:30 P.M. Sessions are February 2, 9, 16, and 23; March 2, 9, 16, and 23.

Registration:

1. Class size will be limited to the first 25 paid registrants for each course.
2. Registration is open from November 30-January 15, or until the classes are filled.
3. The fee for each of the courses is \$350. If there are still openings, late registrations will be accepted until January 25, with a late fee of \$375.
4. Students who previously attended the 2009 Fall SAT or ACT courses may attend the teaching sessions without an additional fee, but they should still register.
5. To register, please forward a check made out to LaSalle High School to Stacy Papke, c/o LaSalle High School, 3091 North Bend Road, Cincinnati, OH 45239. Make certain that the student's name, school, and course preference are included with the check.
6. The student must personally register online for the actual SAT or ACT tests as these require credit card and personal information.

Information:

A student and his/her parents are required to sign a commitment form, which will be mailed with the course information and must be submitted at the first session so that the student is able to continue to participate in the classes. We have found the course to be most beneficial for students who are personally motivated to devote the time required for the sessions.
